## Registrations increased to a new high

Vehicle registrations recorded its highest level over a month since July 2006 with a 24.1% growth during October. The rise was due to increases in almost all major vehicle categories and especially 'light vehicles' with 46.0% growth and the largest share in vehicle registration.

Total vehicle registrations over the year to October also remained firm, with increases in all categories except for motorcycles and buses. The decline in bus' registrations interestingly coincides with the rise in taxis and rentals. This might suggest a general expectation among the formal transportation sector of an increase in consumption. The 52.3% increase in vehicle payments made through the banking system and the 21.1% rise in vehicle lending also support this notion. As earlier liaison suggested; the lighter and inherently cheaper vehicles are the main drivers for the lift and perhaps for the change in consumer behaviour.


Looking forward, the NRBT anticipates continual growth for vehicle registrations in the near-term. As an offsetting factor; the U.S. dollar, which we make most vehicle payments with, has been appreciating against the pa'anga over the last three years. Tonga's real exchange rate index has similarly been depreciating, placing pressure on import prices. Foreign reserves remain at a comfortable level and the developments contained in this release do not warrant a change in the NRBT's monetary policy settings in the near future.




